Many programs are offered in each sector or at more than one camp. No matter what itinerary you take, most of the key programs (rock climbing, horseback ride, chuck wagon dinner, western lore, black powder rifle, lumbering and challenge events) will be available; those are the most popular programs and should be part of your itinerary.

Some programs are offered only at one camp or in one sector. This, the simplest way to determine the general direction of trek is to discover which of the unique programs and terrain types command most of the crew's interests in addition to the multi-sector programs.
